There was great energy in the room as we knitted and joined together in conversation like old friends, all while sipping and nibbling on delicious homemade snacks. Of course, the event wouldn't have been successful without all of your help and participation, so special thanks go to our members!

In the spirit of giving, December brings us two meaningful events we will participate in. The first is Project Christmas Angels through Catholic Charities. We received a plea for help from them, asking if we could help with stockings and gift bags for the hundreds of children of Pajaro, who lost everything from the past winter storms. The Christ Child elves are already busy working to put together 50 gift bags comprised of infant and child clothing, books, knitted hats and booties, and small-sized toys and gifts. We believe our gifts will bring much joy and smiles to the kids during this holiday season.
